





In-house manufacture



Following manufacture on site in Ispringen, near Pforzheim, the brackets undergo seven intensive cleaning steps.

Packaging concept



Once they have been manufactured and cleaned, the brackets are placed by state-of-the-art robots into the hygienic packaging in the correct position – hygienically and with the utmost precision.

No additional cleaning necessary.




FDI notation

For direct and simple allocation to tooth.




Protective foil



Safe packaging concept


Dentaurum packaging fulfills international requirements on the basis of ISO 27020.



Correct positioning

Allows quick and direct extraction.

THREE STEPS TO SUCCESS.



Remove the upper protection foil which protects the brackets from contamination and guarantees they are the original brackets.



Grip the brackets mesially-distally using crimping tweezers through the perforations of each bracket compartment (A), remove the bracket (B) and pretreat as usual.



Brackets are placed directly onto the conditioned tooth surface.
